Practice Times

- Class Entry Fee: \$15/class
 - 9&U Classes: \$10/class
 - MAX Total Entry Fee: \$150/Horse/Rider Combo
 - Trail practice fee: \$10/horse entered in trail
 - Jump practice fee: \$10/horse entered in jumping
- No Refund for missed classes, no shows or scratches at the gate*

- Office Fee: \$5/horse
- Stalls: \$25/night
- Shavings: \$8/bag
- Grounds Fee for Unstalled Horse: \$15/horse
- RV Hook-Ups: \$45/night

- Main Arena closes at 10:00 pm each day
 - Trail courses will be set for practice on Friday
 - Jump Course will be set Saturday Night
- Under Tennessee law, an equine sponsor or professional shall not be liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities**

PRIZES & JACKPOT

ELIGIBILITY

- Ribbons in all classes through 6th Place
- Payback \$5 from each entry in every class
- Entries beyond \$150 must pay \$5 jackpot fee per additional class
- Payouts based on NSBA payback chart
- Money added classes to be determined based on sponsorships

- AQHA RULES APPLY UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED
- Age as of January 1st, 2024
- 9 and under may enter any class not requiring a lope or canter
- Walk-trot 18 and under, Walk Trot 19 and over may show in Novice classes but not youth or amateur classes or open classes with a lope or canter
- Novice classes entries may never have won 1st place at a breed show.
- Youth is defined as participants 18 years old and under based on age as of January 1st.
- A youth cannot exhibit a stallion.
- Amateur is defined as participants 19 and older. An exhibitor/competitor who has not received remuneration for training, instructions, giving lessons, judging or any other equine activity where they received payment for expertise in any riding or showing equine field in the past 3 years.
- In-hand class may only show in the In-hand division.
- Western tack warrants western attire and English tack warrants English attire. Boots with a closed toe and heel are required. Peak Equine Productions, LLC. strongly advise ALL RIDER/PARTICIPANTS to wear ASTM-approved helmets.
