- 1. Open and ride through gate, close gate
- 2. Walk serpentine between logs 1 & 2, and around 3
- 3. Stop between logs 2 & 3, back S passed log 1
- 4. Lope Right lead over log, break to extended trot, ride over logs
- 5. Side pass left over log
- 6. Step over log and walk across bridge
- 7. Pick up rope and walk or trot circle, replace rope (Green Horse: Drag log at walk or trot)
- 8. Trot over logs
- 9. Trot into box, stop, dismount, walk around horse, gather reins and walk out

Peach Country Circuit Open, Amateur, and Youth Ranch Trail




- 1. Open and ride through gate, close gate
- 2. Walk serpentine between logs 1 & 2, and around 3
- 3. Stop between logs 2 & 3, back S passed log 1
- 4. Lope Right lead over log, change leads (simple or flying), lope left lead over log, break to extended trot
- 5. Side pass right over first log, pivot between logs, side pass left over log
- 6. Step over log and walk across bridge
- 7. Open and Amateur Drag log at walk or trot (Youth: Pick up rope and walk or trot circle), replace rope
- 8. Trot over logs
- 9. Trot into box, stop, dismount, walk around horse, gather reins and walk out

REINING PATTERN 4




Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or force

- Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
- $\label{eq:complete} \textbf{2. Complete four spins to the right. He sitate.}$
- Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
- 4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
- Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- 7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- 8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up
- to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
